

## DISCIPLE-MAKING

### SESSION 4: THE MEETING



#### IN THIS SESSION

The three primary ingredients of disciple-making are INTENTIONAL, RELATIONAL, and EXPONENTIAL.



#### KEY PASSAGES

- **Luke 8:51** <sup>51</sup> When he arrived at the house of Jairus, he did not let anyone go in with him except Peter, John and James, and the child's father and mother.
- **Mark 9:2-6** <sup>2</sup> After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. <sup>3</sup> His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. <sup>4</sup> And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus. <sup>5</sup> Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." <sup>6</sup> (He did not know what to say, they were so frightened.)
- **Matt 26:36-38** <sup>36</sup> Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." <sup>37</sup> He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee along with him, and he began to be sorrowful and troubled. <sup>38</sup> Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."



#### DISCUSS

- Look at the following passages from the Bible: Matthew 13:10-23, Matthew 26:36-38, Mark 9:2-6, and Luke 8:51. What distinct privileges were given to Jesus' disciples?
- As you think about INTENTIONAL, RELATIONAL, and EXPONENTIAL; why do you think that each of those are essential to disciple-making? What happens if any of those are lacking?
- If disciple-making requires an INTENTIONAL, RELATIONAL investment in others... how many people are too many to disciple at one time? What are your thoughts?
- As you think about your life right now, begin to envision, what might it look like to invest in another person INTENTIONALLY, RELATIONALLY, and EXPONENTIALLY?



#### PRAY

Who comes to your mind as you begin to catch the vision for discipling? Whom do you know that isn't yet a follower of Christ that you can begin praying for in regards to building a deeper relationship for the sake of the Gospel? Take some time to pray specifically for that person.
