SESSION 5: GOSPEL AND THE WORLD



IN THIS SESSION

Undoubtedly, the Gospel affects each of our individual lives. However, when we are transformed by the Gospel, then we have the call to proclaim that good news to the world for the transformation of others. Are we here to just receive the Gospel, or is there a broader vision?



KEY PASSAGES

- **2 Corinthians 5:20** ²⁰ Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ...be reconciled to God.
- **Matthew 28:19** ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit
- **Acts 1:8** ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.



DISCUSS

- How do you see other people groups? In what ways are you supporting this aspect of the great commission? Maybe you already have a healthy view of the nations and are supporting this mission. Share some ways that you have been able to do this or ways in which you would like to engage in this.
- How is our understanding of the Gospel helpful or harmful in reaching people of other nations or people groups?
- Who are the other people groups that you can reach out to in your own community? If there are none, how do we or why should we seek out other nations?



PRAY

- As you wrestle with and pray through the Gospel for yourself, is God calling you to be one of His agents to spread the Gospel to the world? When you pray, ask this question: Am I engaged in helping people know how incredible Jesus is? Ask who you need to pray for, give to, or serve, per the calling of Matthew 28:19.
