Position Overview

This position provides administrative assistance for Give It Away and Care Ministries of Grace Church at the Medina East Campus. Coordinates logistical tasks related to Give It Away and Care initiatives, events and meetings. This is a part-time, salaried position with occasional evening and weekend responsibilities as needed to meet ministry goals.

Essential Job Functions

Under the leadership of the Give It Away Pastor, coordinates current and future logistics for the purpose of mobilizing the Church to make disciples, live on mission, take part in missions, and provide care for our people and community.

- Provides administrative support of processes and logistics for Give It Away initiatives (GO Teams, trainings, 5&Change, Neighboring, Love Medina, etc.)
- Provides administrative support of processes and logistics for Care initiatives (POC, funerals, weddings, marriage mentors, Prayer Teams, etc.)
- Assists with connecting and onboarding Give It Away and Care volunteers and process queues.
- Assists with managing Associate Pastor of Give It Away's calendar and scheduling.
- Effectively stewards GIA and Care resources; accurately tracking and processing expenses.
- Maintain confidentiality of documents and information as required. Is responsible for data integrity in GIA and Care.
- Represents the Give It Away Pastor and leadership effectively and respectfully, to the congregation and public communicating with professionalism and grace.
- Attends ministry area and All Staff meetings.

- Willingness to quickly learn necessary GraceLINK skills for tracking.
- Acute attention to detail.
- Excellent event planning and people skills.
